We are seeking a Registered Energy Advisor to conduct EnerGuide home evaluations and modelling services throughout GETS Energy service areas in accordance with NRCan's policies and procedures.

## Duties and Responsibilities

We are looking for an NRCan-registered Energy Advisor who works well as part of a team as well as independently. The right candidate for this role will possess excellent time management, a strong attention to detail, analytical skills, as well as the ability to balance multiple competing priorities.

This role entails frequent travel to various locations both on and off Vancouver Island, to perform EnerGuide home evaluations to both new construction and existing homes/buildings. The individual must demonstrate exceptional communication and a positive attitude with homeowners, builders and other GETS staff, and must be well-versed in:

- Mapping and measuring the home/building's building envelope (windows, doors, ceiling, walls, and foundation);
- Identifying insulation levels throughout all areas of the home/building;
- Recording the size and efficiency ratings of space heating, space cooling and water heating equipment;
- Noting the home/building's ventilation equipment;
- Testing for air tightness via use of a blower door test;
- Energy modelling, report development, and advising the client of recommended and effective upgrades within their budget.
